What to expect day to day:

- Clinician appointments take place in one of our multiple consult rooms, coordinated by a team of Patient Care Coordinators. Our personal workspaces are in an open concept environment where you will work alongside our team of Mental Health practitioners and a fantastic multidisciplinary team of healthcare professionals
- Assessing the needs of referred patients to determine relevant treatment plans which may include short-term counselling with a Mental Health Practitioner, and/or referral to group therapy, and/or a referral to an appropriate community agency or regional program
- Counselling patients individually and in a group setting using a range of behavioral techniques such as motivational interviewing, readiness to change, behavioral intentions, self-monitoring, problem solving, goal setting, and others.
- Coordinating care with and/or link patients to other healthcare programs, healthcare providers or other relevant community agencies and resources as appropriate
- Administering metrics and screens to assess effectiveness of treatment
- Providing mental health assessments, individual therapy based on comprehensive treatment plans.
